Display Assignment

The CSHT Host Organizing Committee will attempt to honor exhibitors' preferences for space to the extent allowed by the availability of the requested space, size requirement and proximity to competing firms. The organizers reserve the right to re-assign space or modify the floor plan as necessary to enhance the exhibit. In fairness to all exhibitors, a maximum of two tables per exhibitor will be allowed.

Exhibit Hours

All refreshment breaks (2 half hour breaks per day plus breakfast on Saturday) and lunches (1 hour each day) will be held in the Coal Harbour Ballroom B where exhibitors will be set up.

An Exhibitor passport, with a list of all Exhibitors, will be provided to all delegates. Delegates who visit all Exhibitors (with completed stamped / initialed passports) will be entered in a draw for prizes.

Set-Up and Dismantle

Installation of exhibits begins on Friday, April 21, 2017 between 9:00 and 10:00 am. Booths must remain intact until 15:30 on April 22, 2017. All materials must be removed from the exhibit area by 17:00 on April 22, 2017.

Subletting of Space

Exhibitors may not assign, sublet or apportion to others the whole or any part of the space allocated and may not advertise or display goods / services other than those manufactured or sold by them in the regular course of business.

Liability and Security

Each exhibitor must make provision for the safeguarding of his goods, materials, equipment and display at all times. After conference and exhibit hours your product may be locked in a separate room, but neither the CSHT nor the hotel are responsible for loss of any material by or for any cause. The CSHT strongly recommends that each exhibiting company secure a rider policy through its insurance agent to cover all booth and display items during transportation to and from this Conference, as well as during installation, exhibit days and dismantling.

Visual and Sound Effects

Audio-visual and other sound and attention-getting devices must not interfere with the activities of neighboring exhibits.

Operational equipment demonstrated may not create noise levels objectionable to neighboring exhibitors.

Refund Policy

All space cancellations must be in writing. If received on or before March 31, 2017 50% of the total exhibit space fee will be refunded. There will be no refund for space cancelled after this date unless assigned space is sold to another exhibitor. Refunds will be issued at the completion of the conference.



HOTEL INFORMATION

The 2017 Canadian Society of Hand Therapists Conference will be held at the Coast Coal Harbour Hotel, Vancouver, British Columbia. Coast Coal Harbour Hotel is conveniently located in the downtown area and is accessible via taxi or transit from the city's major international airport.

Individual Room Reservations:

The CSHT Conference Group Rate is \$169.00 + tax per night for double occupancy.

Delegates may call into the hotel directly at 1-800-663-1144 or 604-697-0202 to make their individual reservations.

They must identify themselves as part of the Canadian Society of Hand Therapists Annual Conference to take advantage of the discounted room rates.

Ground Transportation:

Taxi: A taxi from the Vancouver airport to the host hotel will cost approximately \$35.

Skytrain: Skytrain is Vancouver's public subway system. There's a station conveniently located at the Vancouver airport. Follow signage in the airport or ask at the information desk. There's only 1 line (Canada line) and you will take the train all the way to the last station - Waterfront. Cost is \$9 (due to additional airport fee) but only \$4 from downtown to airport. Once downtown, the host hotel is a guick 5 min walk from the Waterfront station.
