The Community Accessible Rehabilitation (CAR) program is an ambulatory multidisciplinary rehabilitation program located in Calgary, Alberta. We're looking for an Occupational Therapist to join our dynamic Upper Extremity/MSK team, located at the Peter Lougheed Centre (PLC). This OT position focuses mainly on hand therapy for clients with a variety of hand conditions/injuries, many of whom will require post-operative splinting, wound care and follow-up. The OT will work closely with Physiotherapists and Therapy Assistants and will also provide support to the plastic surgeons in the PLC Hand Clinics. The successful candidate will need to have a strong interest in hand therapy and in developing advanced splinting skills, as well as being able to support the OT needs of clients with rheumatological conditions and complex MSK diagnoses.

We are looking for someone who is passionate about collaboration, learning and evidence-based practice. The CAR program will provide mentorship and training to the successful candidate.
